Policy statement.

1. For this policy the responsible person is one of the following:
 - The holder of the premises licence – J Schober
 - The designated premises supervisor
 - A person of 18 or over who is authorised to allow the sale or supply of alcohol

2. Staff serving alcohol on the premises must require any individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under the age of 18 years of age to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth, and holographic mark in accordance with Challenge 21 and Under 25 Guidelines (British Beer and Pub Association). Examples of appropriate identification include:
 - A photo card driving licence
 - A passport
 - A proof of age card bearing the PASS hologram
 - Military ID

The premises licence holder will ensure that staff/volunteers and hirers of the premises are made aware of the existence and content of this policy
